

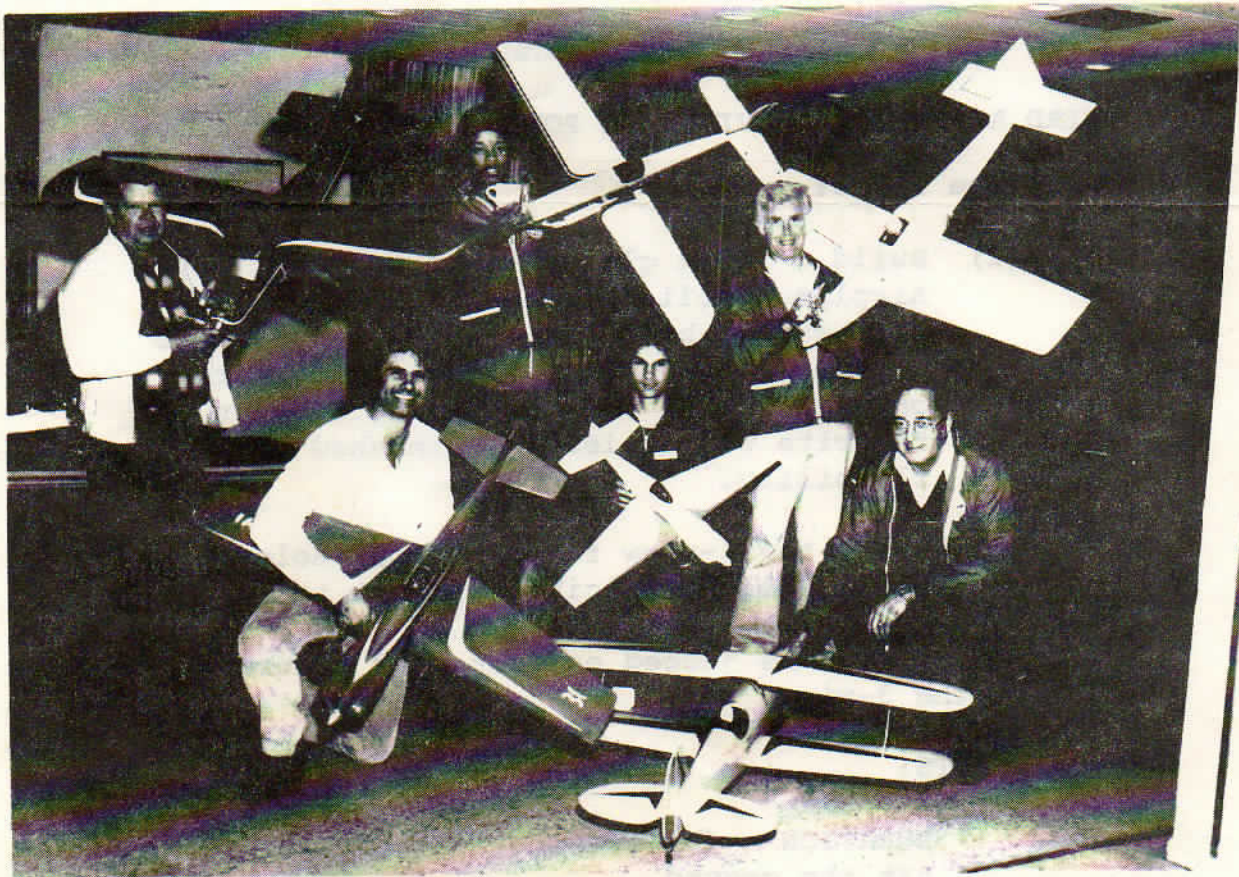

THIRD ANNUAL THREE VIEW ARM POWERED PLANE CONTEST

Here are the rules:

- (1) Build a "dime glider" type model of any airplane published in a magazine, book, or whatever by tracing the fuselage onto $\frac{1}{4}$ " balsa----- wings and tail feathers on $\frac{1}{16}$ ". Cut out and finish in your favorite way or leave unfinished for flyability.
- (2) Bring the 3-view for proof of sacle. No plane will be eligible without it.

Planes will be judged on looks and accuracy to the 3-view.

EVENTS:

DURATION - (by elimination) or last to hit the ground.

SPEED - (by elimination) or first to cross finish line.

DISTANCE - (by elimination) measured in a straight line.

TROPHIES or RIBBONS thru third place. Additional PRIZES for BEST model, BEST finish, and MOST UNUSUAL will be awarded. Each Plane must prove it can fly.

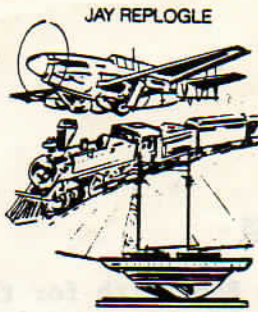

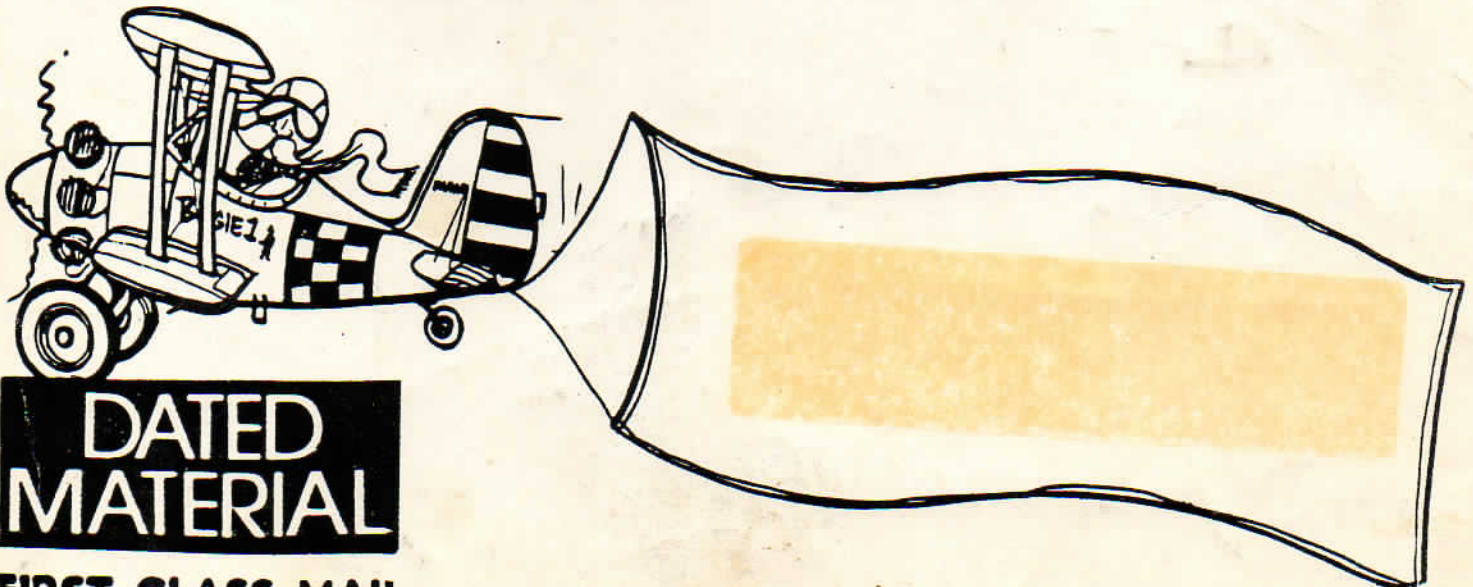
