...How to get there

THE NATIONAL CENTER FOR AEROMODELING is open during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, Federal holidays excepted. For group and off-hour visits, call the Center at (703) 435-0750.

TO REACH THE CENTER from Washington DC: Take any convenient route to the Capital Beltway. Note that Interstate 66 is limited to car pools only in the direction of rush hour traffic during rush hour. Exit the Beltway on Route 7, the Leesburg Turnpike. As you approach Route 606 (see map) you will see a large sign on your right directing you to Reston. Turn left on Route 606 (Baron Cameron Road) and go to the first light, which is Wiehle Avenue. Turn left on Wiehle, and left again on Sunset Hills Road. The Center is on the right, no more than half a mile from the corner of Wiehle and Sunset Hills.



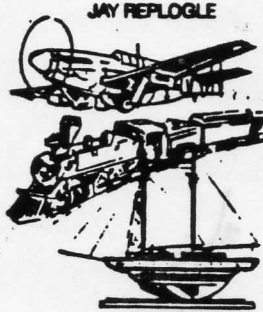

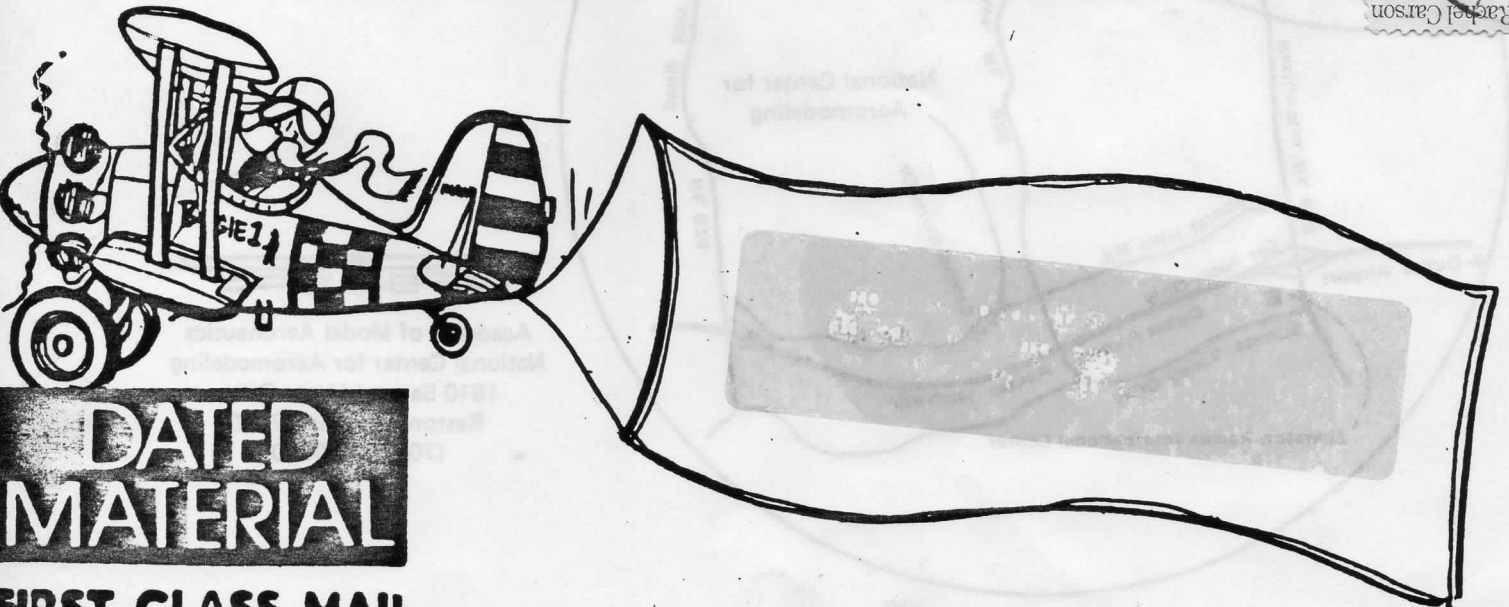
