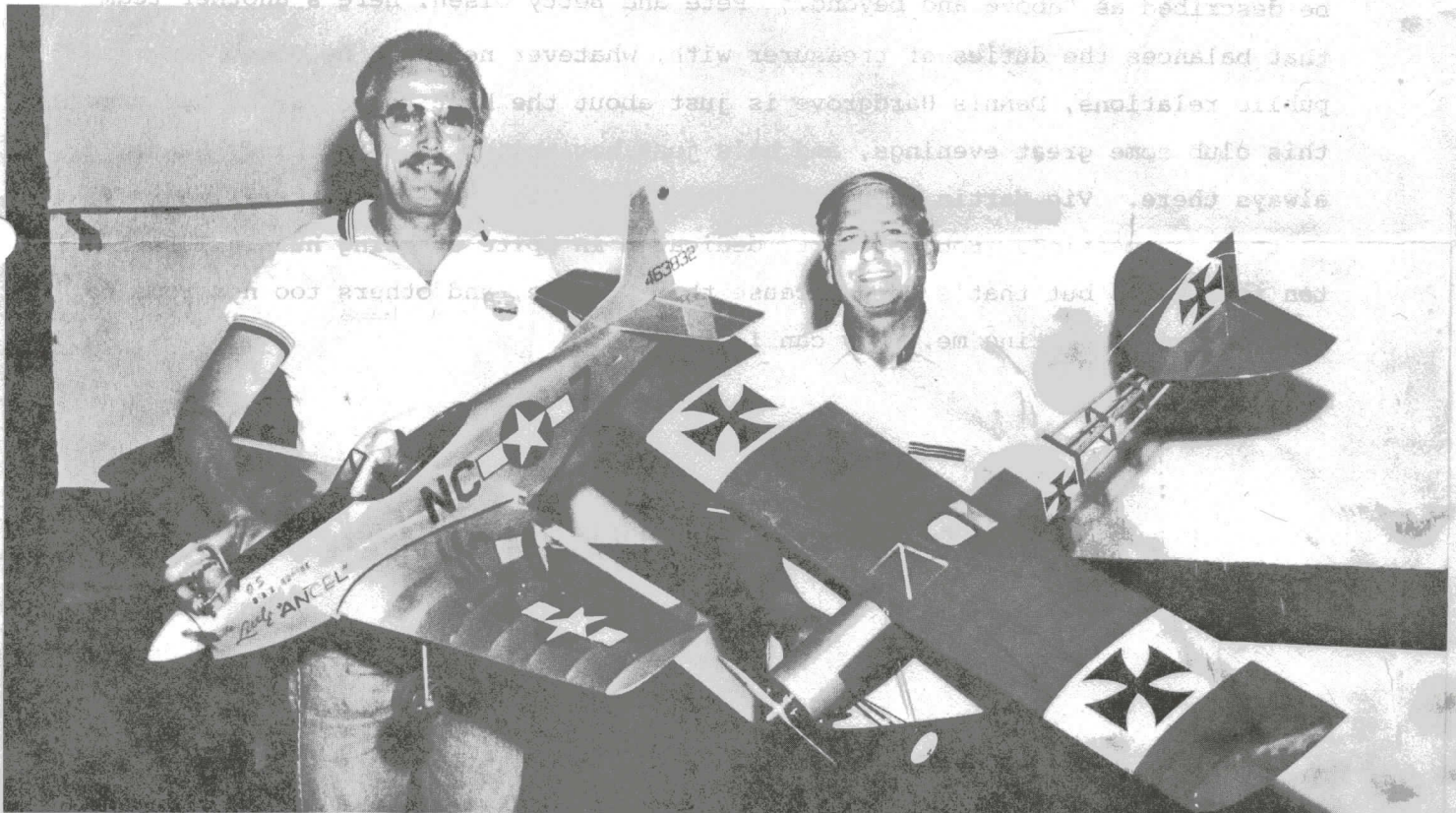

## BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING - JUNE 11, 1984

The meeting was called to order by our president Marty Mallow at 7:35 p.m.

The Board voted to have Mel Gifis serve in the capacity of V. President and Bob Neithart as Event Director. Because of the resignation of Ken Turner from the Board it was necessary to take this action.

Marty showed us the shirts that will be available for purchase by the club members. It was voted to have the Valley Flyer logo silk screened on the back.

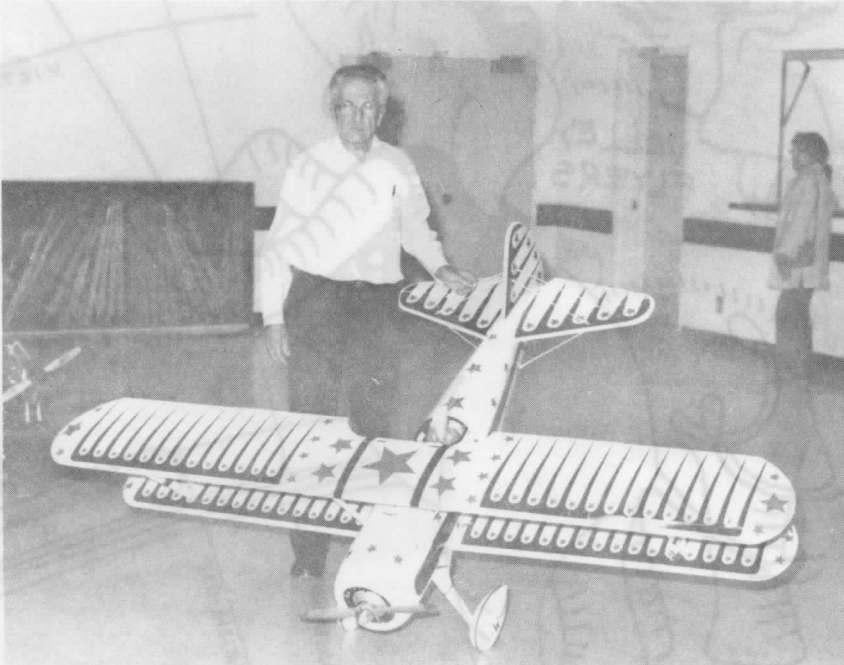
### FOR SALE
