SPEED - (by elimination) or first to cross finish line.

DISTANCE - (by elimination) measured in a straight line.

TROPHIES OR RIBBONS thru third place. Additional PRIZES for BEST model, BEST finish, and MOST UNUSUAL will be awarded. Each plane must prove it can fly.
