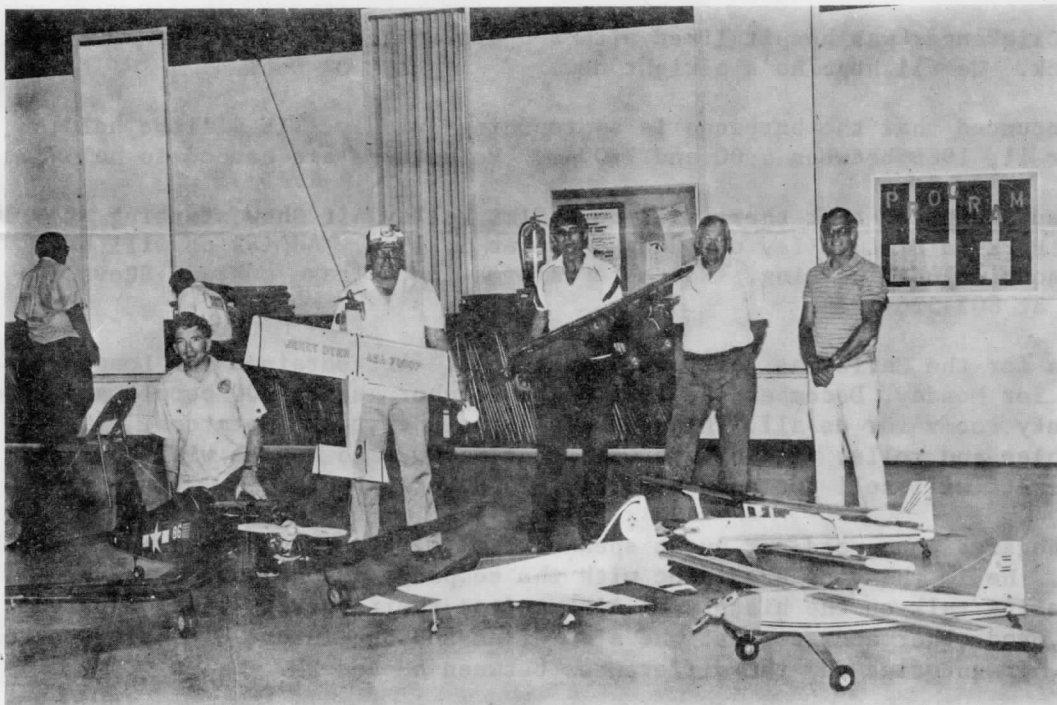

Nominations will be needed to fill four open seats on the Board of Director's.

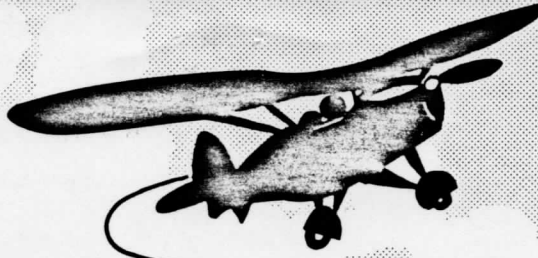
The meeting was closed at 9:15pm.

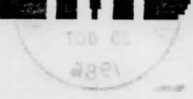

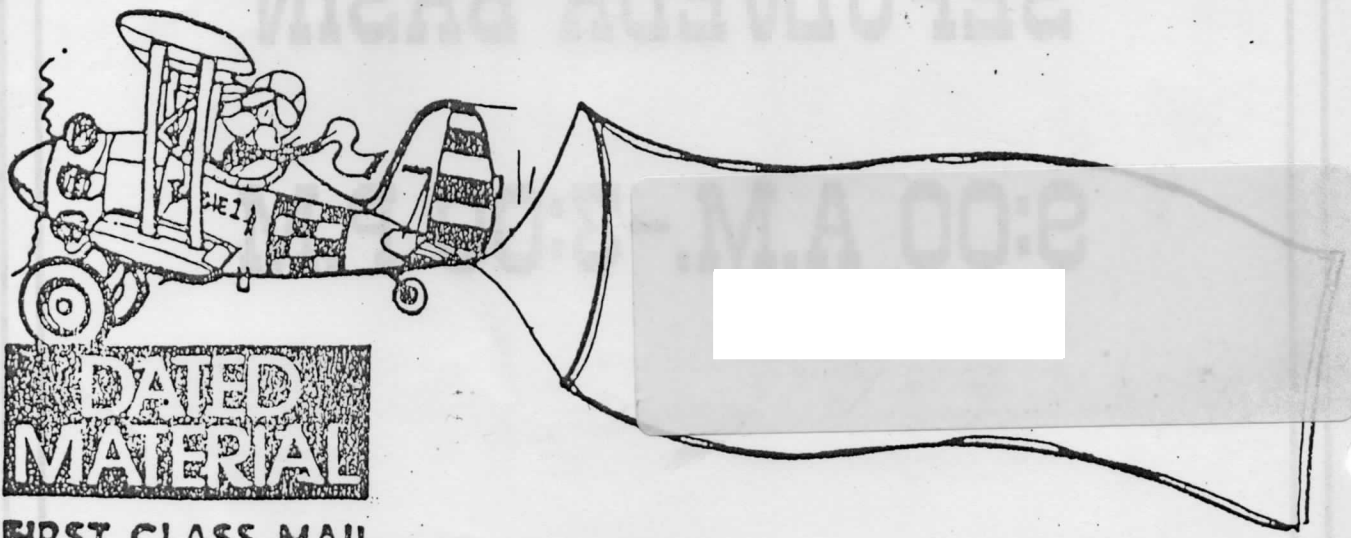
