Pete Chagares made a motion that the modeler of the year award be selected by a committee of past recipients of this award. This motion was passed and unanimously by the board.

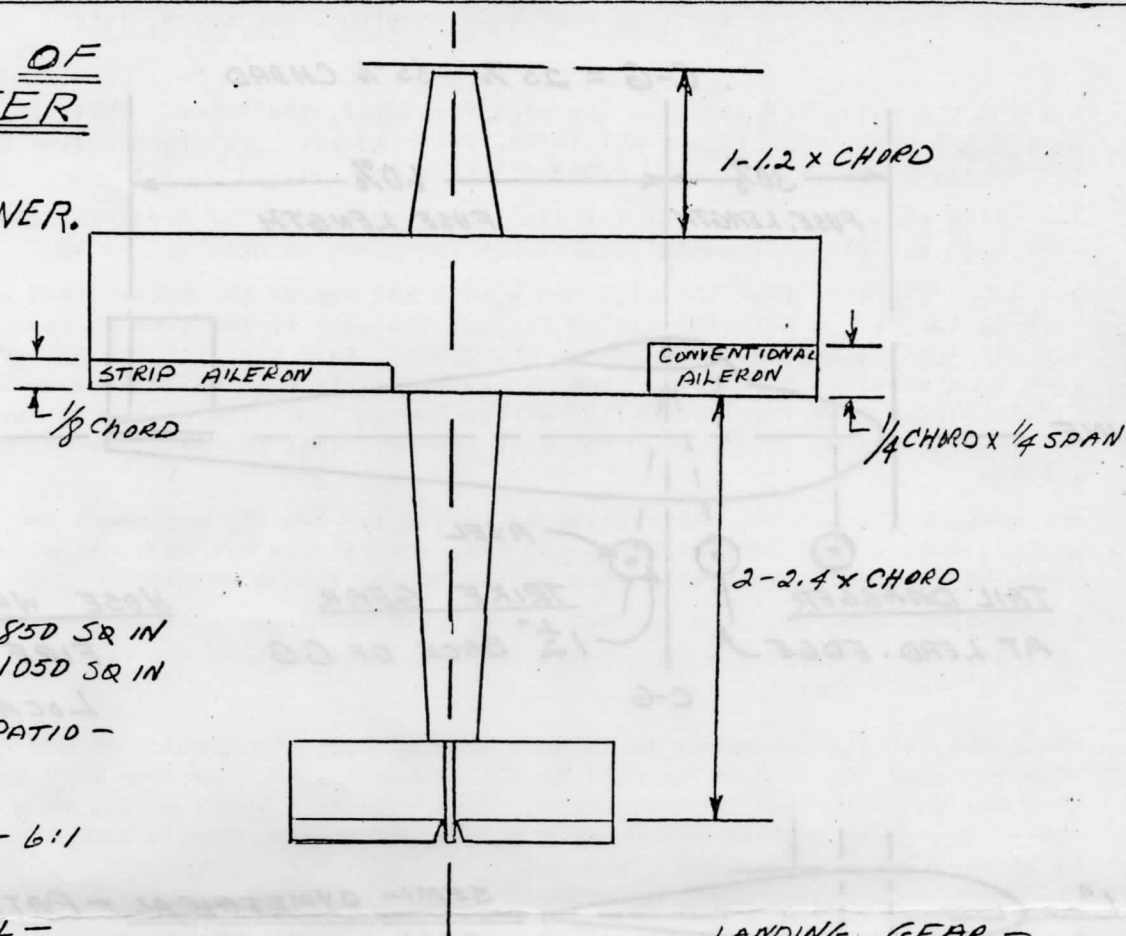

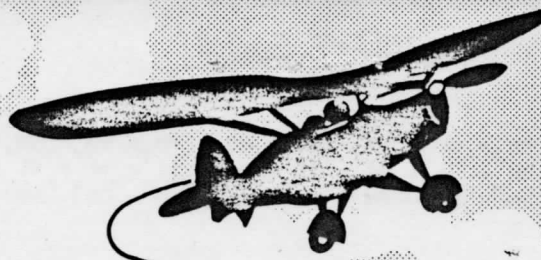


BLUNT LEADING EDGE - GOOD STALL CHARACTERISTICS

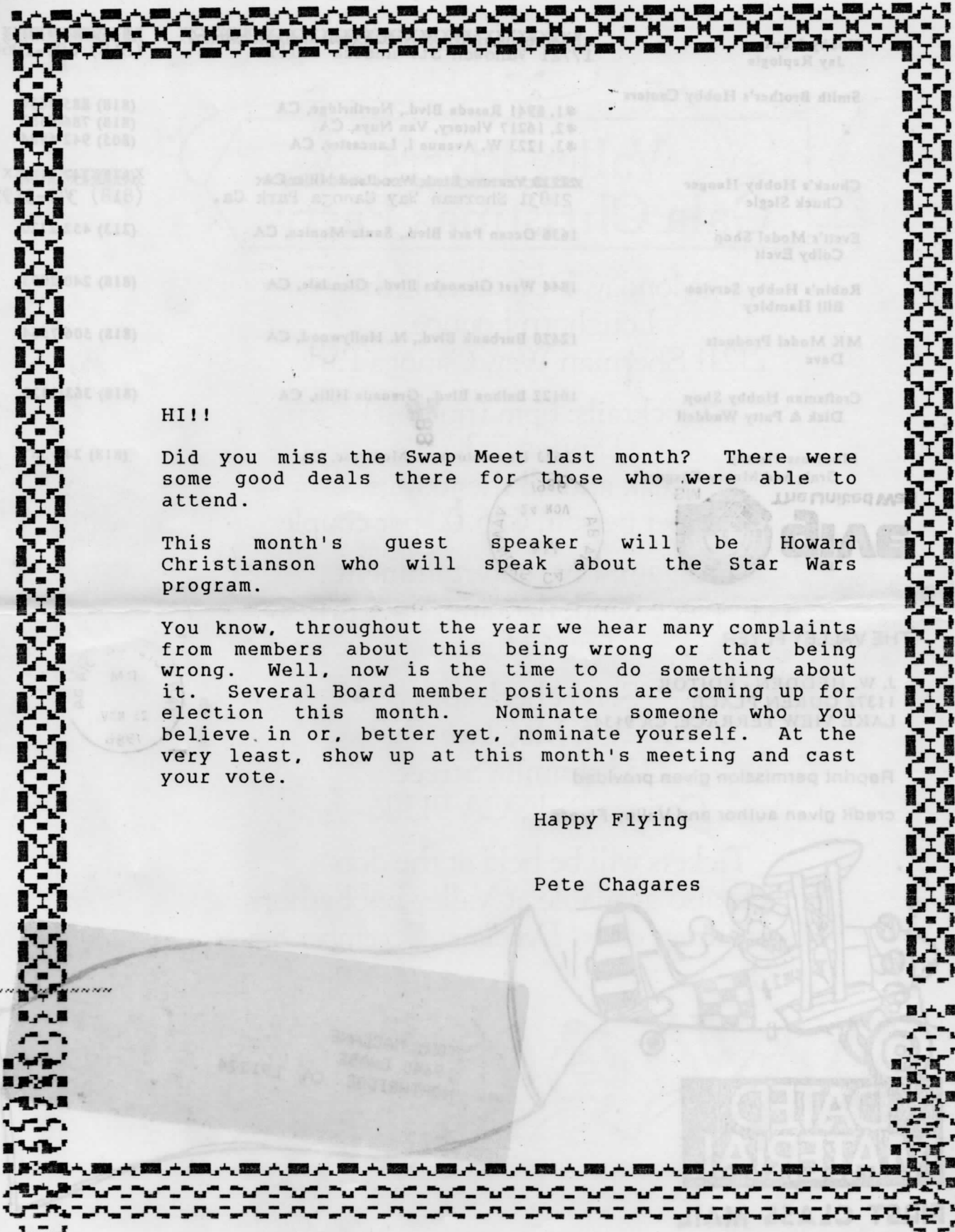

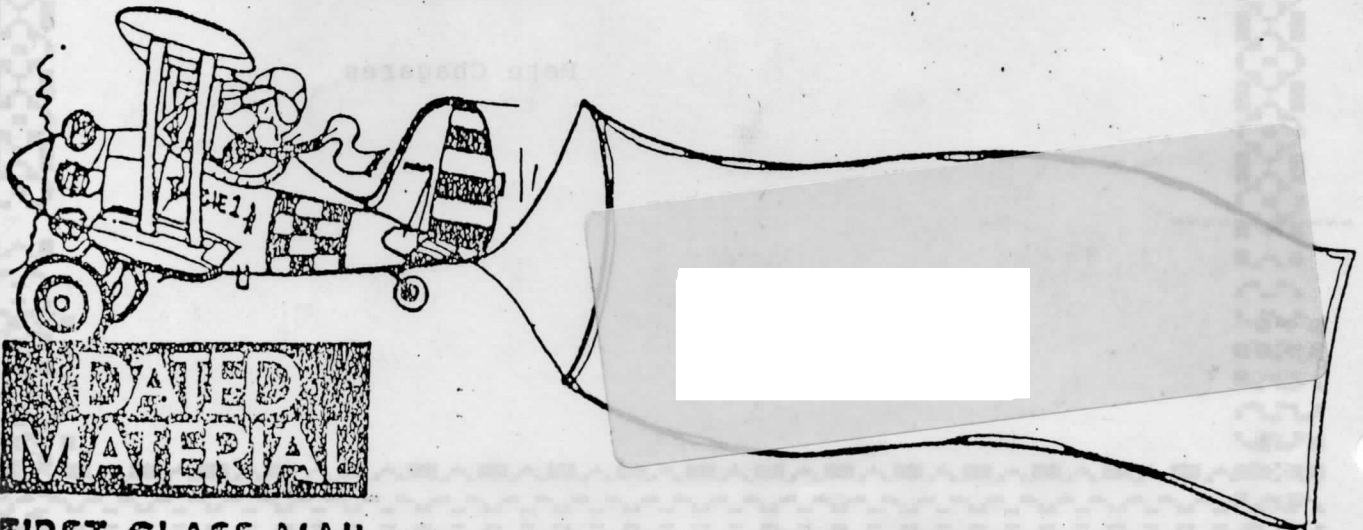
