As of October 8th, the checking balance is \$ 8,487.85. The PAYPAL balance is \$2,031.15.



Board Meeting Minutes, September 7, 2010

#### Jason Pakfar

Willy asked about the park benches from Parks & Recs... Jason said that it has been submitted to the parks for the next year budget.

There is no CD for the 3d Helicopter event so we have no choice but to cancel the event.

We will have to make announcements right away. Sam will send a flyer to Dave for local distribution.

If there are videos available, Jason can put them up on the website. Jason purchased all the parts for the trainers except for 6 servos. The total was 418, including chargers. They did not have receivers. Jason will check at Smith Brothers. Cliff did 3 cards for 2011. Jason will forward them for review. Next meeting will be nominations Jason would like to check back with CSUN about their pricing. The dates available are the  $4^{\rm th}$   $11^{\rm th}$  and  $18^{\rm th}$ . The Toys for Tots event is on the 12<sup>th</sup>, which leaves the 4<sup>th</sup> or the 18<sup>th</sup>. The preference will be the 18<sup>th</sup>. There may be a couple of other location possible. We will be asking 25 from the members and the club will subsidize the rest. We need to recruit a new Helicopter Director before the Helicopter area work can continue. With the loss of revenue for the cancellation of the 3DHelicopter event, the work will be put on hold.

## Chuck Thompson

We have 2 electric and 2 gas small trainers. We are short a wing for one of the electric. There are 3 larger gas trainers. The transmitters that we got for buddy boxes do not work with the DX7s. We need transmitters for the y-fly. If we have radios donated for the event, they would be handled by the children. Chuck suggests that we purchase 4 DX7 transmitters Jason will loan 2 radios. We are still short 1 transmitter for master and 7 transmitters. We only need 4 masters and 4 buddy boxes because that is the most that can fly at 1 time. Scott will loan 1 and Dave will loan 1. We need 3 more receivers. There are no starters. Robert will donate 1 starter. Jason suggests 3 starters, 2 at the flight line and 1 in the pits. The batteries for the gas planes need to be checked.

Bob Tarlou will be the announcer for the event. Mike Brown sent 150 Skystreaks and 20 gliders. Chuck needs to find a computer system with flight simulator loaded. Chuck asked the Black Sheep with help constructing the rubber band planes, but not heard back yet. We are expecting 120-150 kids. Jason has the permits. Chuck will check for the sanctions. We need to check stock on wrist bands. Jason will do a turbine demo and Dave will crash his biplane. Ricc will be doing hot dogs for the concession stand.

Scott asked about the AMA convention. We will deal with it in November. Chuck has received the application. Jason's opinion is to do 3 booths or not at all.

### Dave Sweany

Willy, Dave and Benny have completed the tables. Willy has made signs for proper use of the area. Today, Dave did some work on the bill of materials for the charging station. The cost will be about \$500. The work will begin soon for the new solar installation. Dave will start using the pressure washer before events.

Since Dave took over the position, there's a lot more work for the field maintenance. Willy suggests that we offer some incentives to club members for some basic maintenance chores. Willy suggested we offer worker raffle tickets for this help. We also need to make a list of tasks that need to be done. Jason reminds us that most of the large projects will soon be complete. This will allow more time for regular maintenance. Willy will work on the list of chores. We may consider to use some other incentive besides worker raffle tickets, such as BBQ. We need to develop a field maintenance schedule.

Gary Stevens Membership is at 285.

### Sam Gengo

Sam has been working on the 2011 schedule. Chuck found that the date for the jet event in November will need to be corrected to the 28<sup>th</sup>. We need to come up with a name and date for the March 3D Airplane event. We need to get the dates for the black sheep and control line events. All funflys will have swap meets. We need to email all the other clubs about their schedules to prevent further conflicts. Jason suggests adding another electric fun fly event. The electric events are popular. We need to check for holiday conflicts and other park events across the street.

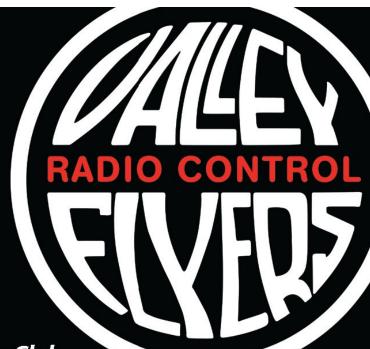




