Foundation Balance \$8756.18 after paying for the runway repairs.

All taxes are paid for 2009 and 2010, and State Fees.

All paperwork for the Foundation are complete and up to date.

Robert had oral surgery today and will not be here tonight.

The runway is complete. It's not perfect, but it should last for a number years. One concern was about the oil spots in the

pits. There is one spot in the pit where the topcoat peeled because of excess oil.

The plumbing repairs in the restrooms and the field in general have been completed.

We had an open house at the Glendale field which went well. Since then, Mario Sweet had a friend at Greg Owens Construction with a bobcat go out and do the first phase of clearing and leveling the area. The cost to the Club is \$40 plus the cost of fuel, which is still pending. An estimated cost if the work had been contracted would have been about 10k. One issue is while Mario was there, the City was dumping green waste because it is designated as an emergency dump and was being used as a result of the recent wind storms. The City will be removing what was dumped, and will also include removing everything we've had cleared. Next step will be to start a plan and stake off the area. Some of the ideas that Jason had was to start off with a container and then a shade structure. One idea is to use petromat for the runway. We will need to look into the cost of the Mat. Dan priced containers. The 20' containers are about \$2275 and the 40' containers are about \$3400.

We need Tee shirts and Caps. Mario will be taking care of this. Chuck will provide the information from the previous suppliers to Mario. We are low on almost all items.

Chuck motioned to get stickers with our logo and web address.

Motion seconded and passed.

Chuck would like to have the additional pit benches installed by that time. We have room for 9 benches. Chuck motions that we make the purchase the materials. The motion was seconded and passed. Chuck would like to have a separate room in one of the containers for Foundation Donations. The cost estimated cost is about 160. Chuck motions for 200 for it's construction. The motion was seconded and approved.

The party is coming up this Saturday at the Presedente Restaurant. Dave Hendrics will be attending the party. Chuck has picked up an award to present him. Chuck has put together a slide show. We will need to bring the PA system and screen.

Chuck has received more donations. One idea would be to have a table at the AMA Conventions. We received a donation from Rudy Hassan.

We still need to contact the Circle Burners about event dates and contact Tony Naccarado too. We need in the next few weeks to evaluate the posters we have to determine what can be reused.

We received an email from RCX offering a boot for \$100 at the long Beach convention center. The dates are April 28th and 29th. Chuck cannot attend this if we choose to participate. Randy made a motion that we do not participate. The motion was seconded and passed.

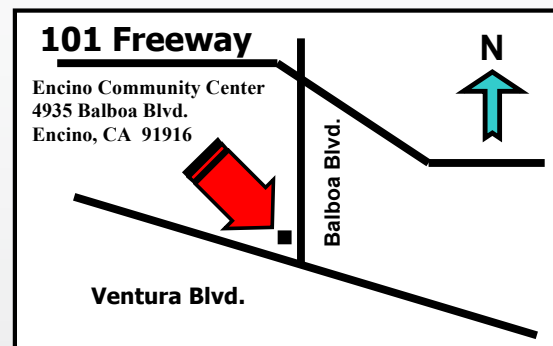
