# FEBRUARY GIVEAWAY

## AT THE TUESDAY FEBRUARY 26th CLUB MEETING



### Monocoupe 110

This month's giveaway features the Monocoupe 110. The Monocoupe 110 Special variant of 1931 was built to meet the needs of racing pilots. The wingspan was shortened from the standard 32 ft to 23 ft, a 125h.p. Warner Scarab was installed and fairings and wheel spats added. Seven of the Specials were built by Monocoupe and three further aircraft were modified to a similar standard by homebuilders. The last Model 110 Special to be completed in 1941 was N36Y "Little Butch", which re-entered the air show circuit in 1946, powered by a 185h.p. Warner Super Scarab engine. The aircraft flew displays until 1981 and was then donated to the National Air and Space Museum in Washington DC.

The DuraFly Monocoupe is constructed from ultra-durable EPO foam, and is beautifully finished with water slide decals. This model really looks the part with its attention to scale detail including wheel spats, large rubber tires, wing supports, rigging wire and molded exhaust pipes. **Being plug and fly, the motor, ESC and servos are all pre-installed.**



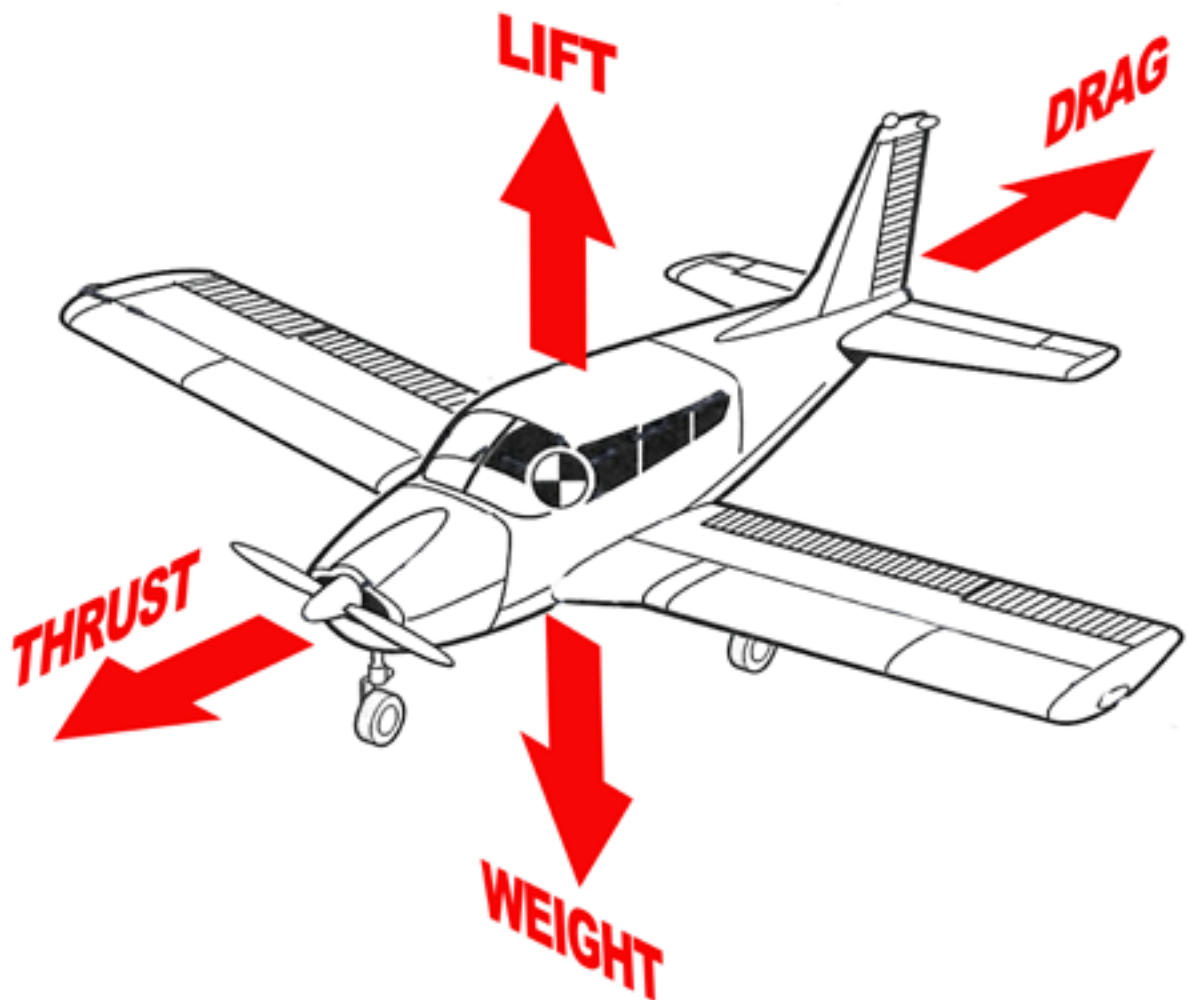

Hello everyone,



As promised this month I will go over the AMA "Turbine Waiver" The waiver is a somewhat misunderstood concept. I will go over the history and then I think it will be easier to understand why we have the waiver for turbine operations.

If you take a look at the AMA safety code, there is a line:

*2.), i.) (Do) Not operate a turbine-powered aircraft, unless in compliance with the AMA turbine regulations. (AMA Document #510-A).*

This is a rewording of an old rule (existing as long as I remember) that stated that an AMA member could not operate an aircraft with a turbine power plant. This was pretty cut and dried.

With the advent of workable, commercial turbines (around 1993), the AMA began investigating granting of "waivers" to this "no turbine" rule, on a case by case basis. Over time, this process was codified and became what we have today, the turbine waiver program. This turbine waiver "waives" the no turbine rule for the holder. In effect this is a license from the AMA to the member to operate turbine powered aircraft under the safety code (now expanded to helicopters and control line!).

At first, the waiver requirement was fairly loosely defined. One had to find a couple of CDs that vouched for your flying (Jay Repogle and Dave Hendrix for me), take a written test at home, send in your answers and hopefully you got your waiver. At that time, one had to also be certified to use each motor, (by a factory authorized instructor!), and then you were issued a waiver that showed which turbines you were allowed to operate.

A lot has changed over the years. First, the requirement to be trained on specific turbines was dropped. Early turbines were started using compressed air, hair driers, blowers etc. With the advent of electric onboard starting, the need for training for each type of turbine was eliminated.

Another big change was the buddy box. Initially, one's first flight with a turbine was literally your first, there was no AMA "legal" way to buddy box someone on a turbine. Now there is no problem with this, an AMA turbine waiver holder can buddy box another member with a turbine model.

We also no longer have to get our signatures notarized (we did at one time) and we no longer have to find a special "Turbine CD". Any CD that has a waiver can sign you off. We have a few in our club

Now for the flying part. You have to demonstrate flying skills in front of a couple of waiver holders, one who is a CD. The flight test requirements have changed over the years, but not significantly:

- a. Takeoff, to be held within 10 feet either direction of centerline
- b. Horizontal Figure 8.
- c. Perform two aerobatic maneuvers with combined looping and rolling elements
- d. High Speed Circuit of the field performed at a safe high rate of speed. (I got this one covered)
- e. Square Traffic Pattern including a missed approach go-around.
- f. Landing to a complete stop.

Anyone with a couple of years of low wing experience can move to this level. Getting used to having that much money in the air is still the largest hurdle in my opinion!

Next month I will go a bit into EDF technology. This is the fastest growing segment of Jet Modeling.

# Apollo XI Field Flying Regulations

**This facility is designed to accommodate four general types of powered remotely controlled aircraft in separate area of the park.**

1. Radio controlled heavier than one pound on the main runway.
2. Radio controlled one pound or less & R/C gliders North of the pit area.
3. Radio controlled helicopters South of the pit area
4. Control line flight in the designated Control line circles

This facility does **NOT** accommodate free flight aircraft, Kites, rocketry of any kind; R/C cars or R/C trucks.



## Radio Control Flight Rules

1. All pilots must fly from one of the designated pilot stands.
2. The frequency board will be used at all times and pilots must post their frequency usage with a card or I.D that contains their name or picture I.D.
3. Open flying is restricted during scheduled events.
4. No take offs and landings from the pit area, taxiways, or grass.
5. 400 feet maximum flying altitude.
6. Take-off and landings to be in the same direction according to the wind.
7. Down-wind passes over the runway are prohibited when other aircraft are flying.
8. Some sort of fuel recovery system must be used when fueling planes to avoid spillage.
9. All pilots will follow taxiways directions as posted.
10. Pilots will call out their intentions (landing, take-off, etc) and clear the runway quickly.
11. There shall be no flying during facility mowing operations
12. Flying over the Golf course, access roads or public roads is prohibited.
13. Each type of aircraft must fly and pit within the area designated on the map for that type of vehicle. Fixed wing aircraft will have a standard left or right pattern depending on the wind.

***Failure to comply with these regulations may result in a citation, loss of flying privilege or both.***

**\*\*Pilots please note, the Field is closed to open flying during all Valley Flyers Events.**

Pilots must check-in to participate. A valid VF Club membership and/or AMA membership is required.
